- <u>Infant education:</u> 0-6 years. Objectives: physical, emotional, intellectual and social development.
  - Infant schools: 0-3.
  - Infant education schools: 3-6.
- Primary education: 6-12 years.
   Objectives: oral expression and comprehension, writing, arithmetic, culture, study and work habits, artistic sense, creativity and coexistence.
  - First stage: 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
  - Second stage: 4th, 5th and 6th.
- <u>Compulsory Secondary Education:</u> 12-16 years. Objectives: discipline, individual and teamwork and study, personal development, appreciation and respect for gender differences, equal rights and opportunities.

Four years divided in 2 stages:

- First stage: 1st & 2nd.
- Second stages: 3rd & 4th.
- <u>Baccalaureate</u>: 2 years and 3 modalities.
   Objectives: knowledge, methods,
   techniques and languages for higher
   studies. Modalities: arts, science and
   technology, humanities and social
   sciences.
